Class Descriptions and Teacher Bios

Jenny Allain – (Angelina Ballerina, Disney Princesses) Jenny recently graduated from college with a degree in Education. Jenny has taught at Dancerz Unlimited for over five years. She enjoys teaching all ages, and has a special fondness for and patience with the youngest students. The Angelina Ballerina workshop will utilize stories from the popular children’s series, and incorporate appropriate music and dance with the age level and experience level in mind. Disney Princesses will involve learning different dances to music from many Disney favorites, such as Cinderella, Snow White, and The Little Mermaid. Both classes will work with props and simplified costumes, and prepare a low-key presentation for the last day of class.

Deanna Doyle – (Musical Theatre Dance, Dance Appreciation) Deanna is a five-year member of the Kansas City Ballet. Deanna has performed in musicals at Theatre in the Park, where she is a two-time winner of Best Female Dancer of the season. Last season, Deanna won this award for her portrayal of Dream Laurie in “Oklahoma.” She has also choreographed shows in recent years at TITP; last summer she choreographed “Beauty and the Beast.” Deanna has also performed at the New Theatre, Starlight Theatre, and in New York at the Joyce Theatre and Lincoln Center. In the Musical Theatre Dance workshop, students will learn many standard steps. Choreography from a different Broadway show will be learned each day. The Dance Appreciation class will involve learning about the important people behind different kinds of dance, such as ballet, tap, jazz, Broadway, movies and pop culture. We will study their work through videos and learn choreography each day, as well. Artists to be covered include: Baryshnikov, Fred Astaire, Bob Fosse, Gene Kelly, Jerome Robbins, and Michael Jackson.

Alex Hess- (Camp Rock, Kidz Hop, Dance Team Preparation) Alex is currently attending Baker University, where she is a two-year member of the Dance Team. Alex had been a student at Dancerz for 9 years, and a teacher for the last 5. She has appeared in “Anything Goes” and “Thoroughly Modern Millie” at Theatre in the Park. Camp Rock will use music from that show, as well as other Disney artists like the Jonas Brothers and Hannah Montana. The class will learn jazz routines and work on their jazz skills. Kidz Hop will be a high energy jazz class for our youngest jazz students, age 6-9. The music and choreography will be age appropriate! Dance Team Preparation class will be focused on learning those particular skills necessary to make the high school dance or cheer team. Technique is stressed, and encouragement abundantly given! Dance team hip hop and pom routines will be learned, along with flag technique.

Kate Hess – (Cheerleading) Kate is in her final year of acquiring a teaching degree in Elementary Education from Baker University. Kate has danced nearly all her life, starting in ballet, and later concentrating on jazz. She was on the Shawnee Mission South dance team for four years, and is currently on the Baker Dance Team. Last year, Kate was a member of the Baker Cheer Squad. The cheerleading workshop will encompass dance technique, learning cheers, chants and jumps, and pom routines. It will be a well-rounded intensive course. P.S. This summer will take Kate back to her ballet basics, as she will play a bride in “Seven Brides for Seven Brothers” at Theatre in the Park.

Tom Land – (Rhythm Tap) Tom is a master teacher, who has many students working professionally in the dance field. Tom owned a very successful dance and acrobatic studio for many years before retiring (we are lucky to get him to come back!). He is one of the only teachers in the KC area of rhythm tap, an old style of tap made new again by Gregory Hines a generation ago, and Savion Glover and Jason Samuels Smith today. In this workshop, Tom will help students explore complex rhythm patterns in a contemporary style. It’s fast, it’s fun, and you will improve your tap technique!

Kelly Miles – (Contemporary) Kelly has a degree in Dance from UMKC, and has been teaching at Dancerz Unlimited for the past five years. Kelly excels in teaching ballet, jazz and lyrical. Kelly also teaches at Kansas City Ballet. If you’ve ever watched “So You Think You Can Dance” you’ve seen contemporary dance. It is a fusion of several other styles of dance: ballet, jazz, modern, and lyrical, performed to contemporary music. The class will work on both technique and expressing emotion through dance.
